Literacy (Ms. Sri Devi Narairai)

Our themes for this term are Dinosaurs. This term, students will learn the phonic sounds and writing the lower case alphabet from g to p. They will also be encouraged to recognize the letters through flash card reading and hands on learning. Students will be exposed to their own name writing. Students will be introduced to the Jolly Phonics Scheme this term. They will complete Phase 1 by the end of this academic year. Phase 1 will include reading and recognition of CVC words. The second half term, students will learn about sight words. They will be introduced to various sight words to help them to build a better vocabulary for reading.

Numeracy (Ms. Sri Devi Narairai)

Topics covered in this term will include: learning to write numbers 6 to 10 and its value. Students will learn to count in ascending and descending order from 1 to 10. Student will also be taught to differentiate shapes according to their level of understanding. The concept of 'more than 5' and 'less than 5' will also be covered this term. Students will learn to classify (colours and specific groupings) and create patterning sequence of AABB pattern; concept of differentiating 2 attributes when distinguishing height (tall and short) and length (long and short).

Understanding The World (Ms. Sri Devi Narairai)

In Understanding the World, we will be focusing on one theme this term which is Dinosaur. Children will learn about extinction of the dinosaur and how it happens. Students will be taught to categorise the dinosaur in different categories. They will also learn to categorise the dinosaurs according their diet; herbivore, carnivore and omnivore. Students will learn about fossil and allow students to understand how human learn so much about them. They will learn about different names of the Dinosaur and their characteristics. Students will have the opportunity to make dinosaur craft using recycle materials. We will be going to the Top at Komtar for a field trip to their Jurassic Research Centre.

Advanced Mandarin (Ms Heng Yue Shi)

This term, Mandarin as First Language for Early Years will continue to develop on the topic of My toys. Students will learn to pronounce their age, name, and compare things like big/small, up/down, more/less etc. In terms of writing, students will continue to learn basic strokes and how to write simple mandarin characters. Students will also be taught to recognize words by matching them to pictures and images. Mandarin music songs will be used as part of the lesson to help students master the language.

Intermediate Mandarin (Ms Heng Yue Shi)

This term, Mandarin as First Language for Early Years will continue to develop on the topic of My toys. Students will learn to pronounce their age, name, and compare things like big/small, up/down, more/less etc. In terms of writing, students will continue to learn basic strokes and how to write simple mandarin characters. Students will learn to speak simple sentences using the vocabulary learned and taught how to recognize words by matching them to pictures and images. Mandarin music songs will be used as part of the lesson to help students master the language. Intermediate Mandarin students will learn the same topics as first language, however not as in depth.

Performing Arts (Mr Myron and Ms Spedding)

Music: During Music lessons, students will participate in a range of activities to develop their sense of pulse and rhythm, and eventually learn to sing songs. Initially, some students might only sing individual words or phrases but as their confidence grows, so will their ability to perform the entire song with all the actions.

Drama: In Drama, lessons will include actions with animal stories, props and characters to engage children. Student will take turns to chant with clear diction. There will also be a range of drama games for students to develop their awareness of sound, movement and creativity and imagination.

Bahasa Malaysia (Ms. Sri Devi Narairai)

This term, students will be exposed to simple syllable words such as 'ayam' and 'itik'. They will be continuing learning Bahasa Around Us for their increase in vocabulary in Bahasa words. They will be taught daily Bahasa communication and pronunciation skills. They will be more reading on vocal and consonants words which are related to alphabet from a-z. They will be doing craft for each alphabet they have learnt. This is to develop creativity in communication skills which can lead to simple story telling in Bahasa.

Physical Education (Ms. Emily Tan and Mr. Dennis Lee)

During this term, students will complete a range of movement and core strength activities for the PMP Fitness Unit. As their technique improves, students will also benefit from developing components of fitness including speed, endurance and power. These activities will help improve their hand-eye co-ordination, develop motor skills and spatial awareness. During the second half of term, students will continue with PMP Minor games with activities that will help develop muscular endurance, flexibility, coordination and motor skills that provide the foundation necessary for success in their early school year.





ICT (Mrs. Haniza Hussin)

In this term, students will be introduced to paint using computer. A picture will be selected from the coinciding themes and will be stored on the paint software. Therefore, the key components is to paint the picture inside the line and not getting out from the outline of the picture. With this, the students tend to control the mouse diligently and build focus on table work given. This will build their interest in using computers and using the computer mouse confidently.

Expressive Art & Design (Ms. Sri Devi Narairai)

This term, students will use different kinds of materials from the environment to do printing and drawing. Students will be encouraged to bring in recyclable materials from home to carry out this project. They will be experiencing painting activities using different types of environment theme materials. They will be also doing dinosaur's puppet using recycle boxes to enhance their story telling time. The learning focus this term will be creative thinking.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (Ms. Sri Devi Narairai)

This term, students will learn about responsibilities and working together. They will work in small groups to build simple objects. They will also learn how to deal with their feelings more effectively as they will be encouraged to express themselves using words instead of resorting to crying when they are corrected. They will be also challenged with some behavior games to enhance and keep track their behavior in class and outside class. They will be reminded to use their "please" and "thank you" daily.
